

## HALDANE MARTIN

Haldane Martin is one of South Africa's celebrated furniture designers. Like the renowned designers Ron Arad, Harry Bertoia and Le Corbusier he is inspired by natural and organic forms.

Haldane's biomorphic designs as in the "Hex Tables" is reminiscent of the versatility of design during the Bauhaus period.

The "Simplicity chaise lounge" is a classic postmodernist reinterpretation of the icon Le Corbusier chaise.
